

The school will do its best to:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Inform and update parents with new information, procedures and guidelines as school becomes aware of them;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19. This will mean your child will need to self-isolate for at least 14 days;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy and appendix for Covid-19 as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Provide learning for pupils who are unable to attend school due to self-isolation of themselves, a family member or if they have been a 'contact' of someone who has tested positive;
- Ensure that staff on doors are wearing face protection (mask or visor) during drop-off and pick up;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, texts, email, Twitter and the school website.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, **I will not send them to school. We will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know** as soon as possible via telephone and **communicate test results immediately;**
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, **I will collect my child from school immediately;**
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will **adhere to the social distancing rules**, including **lining-up on the marked lines and using the one-way system** in school. This includes making sure **my child / children lines up with me on the lines and making sure they understand that they cannot play on the trim trail and tyre park;**
- In order to protect myself and others within the school community, **school has requested that face coverings be worn when on the school site at times of drop-off and pick-up;**
- To assist with social distancing guidelines when dropping off and picking up from school, I will make sure it is **only one adult** and if any other adults collect my child / children, they are **familiar with the school procedures for dropping-off and picking-up;**
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly **stick to the school timings** for my child;
- my child should **not bring any unnecessary items** into school with them or take any home from school;
- a member of school staff may need to take my child's temperature during the day if they feel, or present as being, unwell;
- I will need to **remind my child about social distancing rules** but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully;
- I will need to **explain the importance of good respiratory and hand hygiene** and reinforce this at home;
- I will **not be allowed into the school building without a pre-arranged appointment** and that I can make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to **support all staff** in their efforts to make the school environment as safe as possible and minimise risk of the virus spreading;
- I need to **read all letters/messages/emails** that are sent home;
- I need to **inform the school immediately** of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
- I may need to **support my child / children with learning at home** in the event of them needing to self-isolate;
- **If my child demonstrated behaviour considered unsafe, school will contact me to collect them at the earliest opportunity.**

I will do my best to:

- **follow social distancing rules** in class and in the playground;
- **Tell an adult if I feel unwell;**
- **Not bring things into school from home;**
- **Only use the equipment provided to me by school** and no other;
- **Stay in my own bubble** of children;
- **Stay in my own designated areas** for learning and play;
- **Only enter and exit the school building and grounds from the designated gate and door;**
- **Follow good respiratory hygiene:** coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- **Follow good hand hygiene** – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Tell my teacher, Mrs Morgan, Mr Quarry or another trusted adult in school if I have a problem or am worried about something;
- **Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;**
- **Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I may be sent home** and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
